The Klondike Relay 110 mile course began in Skagway, Alaska and finished in Whitehorse in Canada's Yukon Territory. Nat's team placed 11th out of 91 ten-person teams. November 3, 1993**

In the absence of President Tom Kaiden and Vice President Darragh Ellerson, Treasurer Norm Robinson called the meeting to order.

Bob Murphy announced that 5 individuals had paid the \$2.00 advance registration for the Juniper Hill race. Fifteen to twenty are expected on race day, when \$5.00 will be the fee.

This year's Leaf Peepers race was declared a success.

Mac Gardner-Morse suggested that thank you letters be sent to The World and The Times-Argus expressing appreciation for their coverage of CVR news this past season.


The CVR bank account currently contains \$5,000, but the invoices from the Leaf Peepers race have not yet been paid.

Norm brought up the discussion of the end of the season dinner celebration at Julio's. Tom Kaiden picked up the tab for the group and later submitted it to the club. Norm asked for feedback and opinions were expressed. Ultimately, a motion was made and seconded to reimburse Tom. For future social functions, it was agreed that whether or not the club will pay will be advertised in advance. Rather than make a strict policy about payments, the club will decide on an ad hoc basis.

Traditionally, the club has skipped a December meeting. The next gathering will be the Annual Meeting on January 16, 2:00 pm at Norm Robinson's house. We'll be electing officers at this meeting; the comment was made that the President and the Vice President are not permitted to extend their terms beyond 2 years.

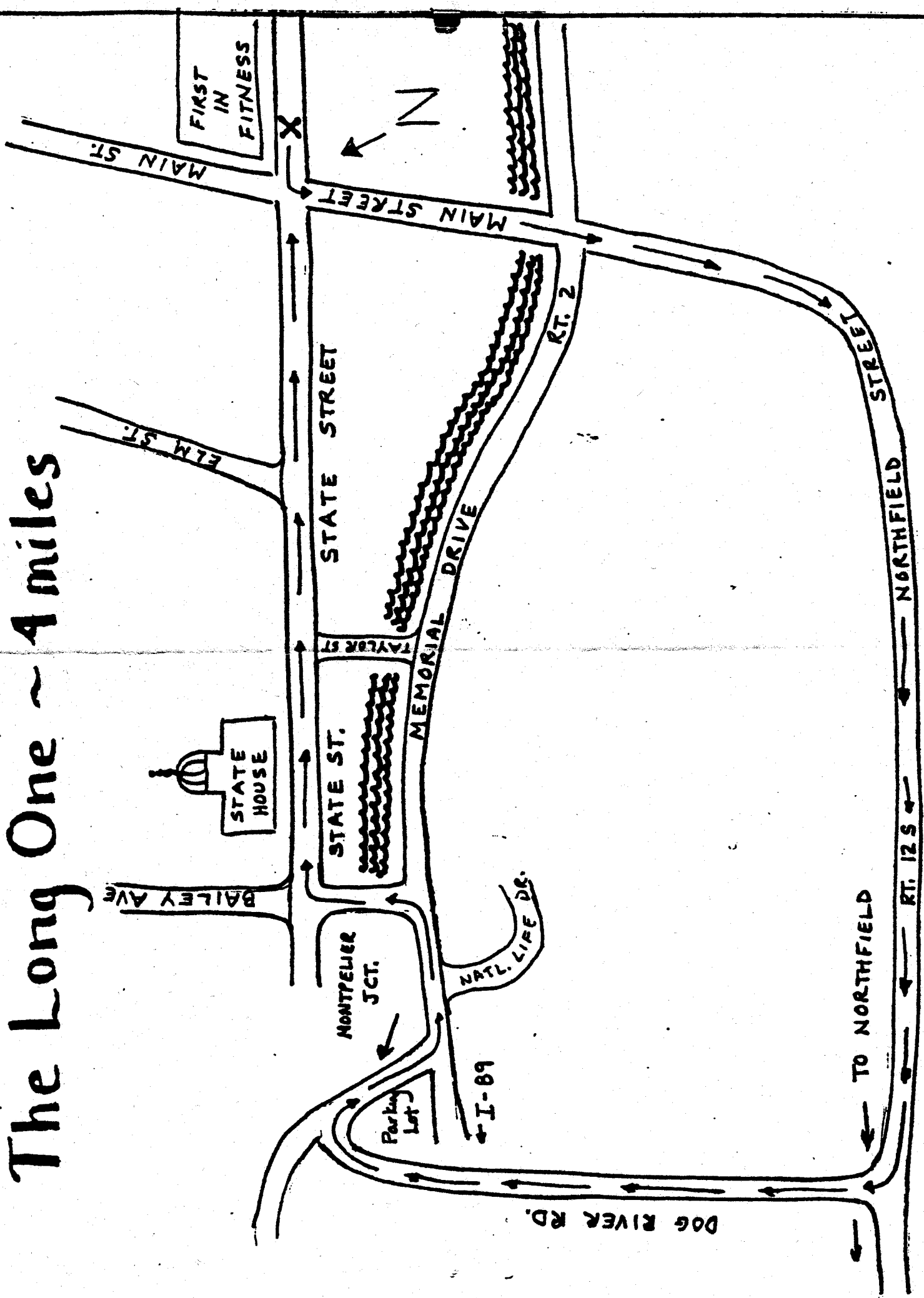
