Due to the decreasing numbers of people showing up for CVR meetings and in the hopes of making meetings more enticing, it was decided that meetings should be held less often, perhaps every couple of months or every six weeks or so. Also, to draw more people, each meeting should have a "hot topic" or

a speaker. Nancy Schulz has volunteered to try and line up a podiatrist to speak on orthodics for our next meeting. Dot Helling will talk about her experiences running 100 Milers at our November meeting. The newsletter seems to be getting thinner and thinner each issue. It was decided that fewer, but hopefully thicker, newsletters would be issued.

Bob Murphy suggested an event for next summer: a one hour track run at the Montpelier High School track.

Our next meeting is scheduled for September 21 at Bob Murphy's house. Upcoming meetings will be held on November 30, January 25, and April 19. The January meeting will serve as the Annual Meeting as well as a post holiday celebration and the April meeting will "require" attendees to bring a friend.
