I had a very positive meeting with Don Lorinovich of the Montpelier Recreation Department. During the meeting, Don put forth some interesting ideas regarding how the Rec Dept. could work with CVR to sponsor an event next year. I'll be interested to hear your thoughts on Don's proposal.

Also, Gordon MacFarland will be presenting an idea to the club regarding another possible new event for next year. I won't steal Gordon's thunder by revealing any of the details here, but I encourage you to come and hear what he has to say.

Does anyone have any thoughts on how I might succeed in getting any of the local radio stations to agree to a live or taped promotion of our Fun Runs? So far, I haven't been able to succeed with WDEV or WSKI. Your input on this matter would be welcome.

I was lucky enough to get permission to hang our Fun Run flyer in the kiosk on State Street. This is a terrific spot for exposure because there is so much daytime foot traffic past it. It's also lit at night. But, best of all, it's in a locked display case, and will remain on view throughout the running season.

Thanks to Race Director, Sam Davis, and all those who contributed to the success of the Capital City Stampede on June 10. We had a wonderful (though warm) sunny morning and the volunteers did a fine job organizing and executing this event. Good luck to all CVR entrants in the 10-miler, scheduled for Saturday, June 24.

The Montpelier Recreation Department is seeking a track and field coach. The commitment involves 90 minute sessions on Tuesday and Thursday nights (and two Saturday meets) for one month this summer. Minutes (reported by Dave Kissner) 17 May, 1995

CVR Scholarship Committee:

Reported that the \$500 allotted was divided into \$200 each to the only two applicants. Reasons for such a low number of applicants was discussed.

It was motioned to give the scholarship as listed above to the two applicants, motion passed.

Motioned to discontinue scholarship in lieu of reporting in <u>this</u> newsletter that CVR is soliciting ideas to redirect these funds. Motion passed. Input for where to redirect the \$500 is hoped for at the June 28 CVR meeting.

Ideas were discussed to redirect scholarship funds to other youth-oriented activities. Youth track programs, specifically a summer track and field program through the Montpelier Recreation Department, was lobbied as a good idea to this end. Another idea was incorporating a 1 mile kids fun run as part of one of the established CVR races.

Race Clock: Bob discussed that \$1,000 is still set aside to purchase a race clock. However, \$3,000 is required for a double face clock, purchased new, as used clocks are virtually unavailable.

Publicity:

Mack supplied a list of newspapers for public relations, and the newspaper list has already been sent to Norm to incorporate into the full mailing list. This would provide, for *Vermont Sports Today* in particular, ample time to list CVR races in calendar sections.

The difficulty with several of the media outlets was discussed. Gordon said he would check into the situation with the *Times-Argus*: Darragh mentioned that persistence is the key to working with radio station WDEV. Tom may be asked to appear on DEV (utilizing his "influence" with the Stowe Area Association.)

Fun run posters were distributed among meeting attendees; a goal of getting 20-30 runners to fun runs was mentioned. Discussed the success of including the fun run notice/CVR application with the Corporate Challenge race bibs and information.

Mailings: Mailing was completed on the week of May 15 for Capital City Stampede and the Paul Mailman 10-Miler. Included with the race entry forms were CVR applications. It was suggested to mail Berlin Pond Couples Race with the Leaf Peepers 5K/Half Marathon.

Next meeting: Was agreed upon for June 28, 6:30 pm at Darragh's house.


