Roger Whitcomb has come up with some recommended guidelines for carpoolers to make it easier for riders who don't know how much is fair and for drivers who might feel reluctant to ask. The guidelines are based on average costs and are intended to gen-Doug Jones has been putting forth erally represent a sharing of fuel costs.

- 1 rider + driver Rider pays \$0.30 for each 10 miles travelled.
- 2 riders + driver Each rider pays \$0.20 for each 10mi travelled.
- 3 riders + driver Each rider pays \$0.15 for each 10mi travelled.
- 4 riders + driver Each rider pays \$0.12 for each 10mi travelled.
- 5 riders + driver Each rider pays \$0.10 for each 10mi travelled.

Example: Race 50 miles from Montpelier. Driver with 3 riders. Total distance travelled is 100 miles; each rider therefore pays \$1.50.
