Annual Meeting of the Central Vermont Runners Club

At 4:30 p.m., on Sunday January 16, the Central Vermont Runners Club convened for the organization's annual meeting at the home of Michael Chernick in Montpelier. The annual meeting's two primary purposes are to elect officers for the upcoming year and to plan the race schedule. The club members present unanimously elected the following slate of officers: President, Norman Robinson, Vice President, Richard Cleveland, Secretary Michael Chernick and Treasurer Laura Medalie.

Jamie Shanley has agreed to continue as newsletter editor and Dave Kissner will remain as the CVR webmaster. Norm will contact Mack Gardner-Morse to request his continuing as the club's publicity director. Donna Smyers volunteered to assume Norm's long standing duties as mailing coordinator. It was decided to maintain annual club dues at the \$10.00 level for regular memberships and \$2.00 for students. On a related issue, there was discussion of mailing a recruiting letter to increase membership. The last personnel matter was Tim and Maureen's assumption of responsibility for course certification activities.

Laura 's treasurer's report in sum stated that after the \$1,774 payment that the club owes to the Harwood Boosters for services performed at the Leaf Peepers Half Marathon, the remaining balance is approximately \$4,500.00. Norm also announced that the Road Runners' Club of America dues for this year are paid.

It was mentioned that several runners at the First Night 5K complained that there was not a clock at the finish line. The topic of CVR purchasing a clock has been discussed at prior meetings. While there was no immediate interest expressed in purchasing a clock, Norm will investigate the possibility of renting a clock from the Green Mountain Athletic Association in Burlington. The three races that this would possibly affect are the Capital Stampede and the Ten Miler in June and First Night in December. Both Northfield and Leaf Peepers have a clock as part of the contract with Granite State Racing, and the remaining races are too small to warrant its use.

Norm and Dave reported that they have met with Andy Brewer, the new owner of Onion River Sports. In a cooperative effort that would mutually benefit both CVR and Onion River, Andy has proposed donating \$1,600.00 in gift certificates to the club for use as prizes at a series of grand prix events that Onion River would sponsor. CVR would pay for trophies for the overall winners in the series for each age and gender category. The designated races would most likely include: Capital Stampede, Ten Miler, Bear Swamp, Berlin Pond, and First Night. After discussion, the club voted to authorize Norm and Dave to finalize this proposal with Andy Brewer.

As for specific races, Norm has not committed to directing the July 4 1-miler, and the future of this race remains uncertain. As a result of its success in 1999, Bear Swamp will remain a Thursday evening race. Berlin Pond will no longer be advertised as a couple's race and will be operated as a standard race for individual runners under a new name the Berlin Pond Run Around. Registration for the race may be moved to the race site. Leslie Davis will be meeting with the Duxbury Select Board to secure a written agreement for the Leaf Peepers race course to pass through that town. In recognition of her outstanding work, it was decided to increase Leslie's compensation.

Dave reported that website hits continue to increase as the site's popularity grows. The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 after deciding to reconvene for the next CVR business session on March 14 at 6:30 at Darragh's.
