CVR Meeting minutes - November 28, 2000

The Central Vermont Runners' Club gathered for a potluck supper and business meeting at the home of club President Norm Robinson, on Tuesday November 28, 2000. The meeting began with the announcement that the club now owns a new bullhorn for starting races. The old horn was no longer functioning, and the new one will be very useful at the starting line.

Dave Kissner, director of the First Night Race, reported that applications for the race were printed and that a new feature of this year's festivities would be a post race raffle. The top winners will be awarded running shoes or a sports bag. The race is to be held on New Year's Eve, with registration and post race ceremonies scheduled for the auditorium at the Pavilion State Office Building. In preparation for First Night, discussion turned to the Onion River Grand Prix standings, First Night being the final race in the series for the year 2000. Norm commented that CVR's calculations may not be complete, and he suggested consulting with Onion River Sports. Dave will make the contact. Norm reminded everyone that CVR remains responsible for the purchasing and awarding of Grand Prix prizes. Norm will review any preexisting criteria for the awarding of the prizes.

Richard Cleveland had previously recommended to the membership that the club purchase a set of "Road Race in Progress" signs for use at CVR sponsored events. The signs, which are manufactured by Sign Design in Montpelier, are comprised of corrugated plastic and mounted on a wire frame. Tim Noonan moved that the club purchase 6 double sided signs at the approximate cost of \$36 per sign. The motion was approved, and Richard will be responsible for arranging the purchase.

Our colleagues from Chittenden County, the Green Mountain Athletic Association, will be celebrating their Diamond Anniversary in 2001. They have invited CVR members to join them at a midsummer celebration featuring both relays and a barbeque. The CVR members viewed the proposal most favorably. The July event might be the initiation of an annual interclub soiree. Subsequent to the meeting, Norm reported that July 22 was a possible target date for the combined clubs' gathering.

On scheduling matters, it was decided that the annual meeting will not be combined with any Volunteer/Grand Prix awards event. The annual meeting is devoted to a busy agenda of business matters for the year, and it was not deemed a good match for an awards celebration. A
Volunteer/Grand Prix event (similar to the dinner held in 1998 at the Methodist
Church) was decided upon. If possible, the same venue will be used and the dinner would occur in late February or early
March. Tim will investigate the date and site availability and Dave will serve as liaison to Onion River Sports. A possible prize would be customized coffee mugs.

Keeping on pace, it was announced that with the purchase of new timers our deficiency in this vital area had been solved.

The CVR Annual Meeting will occur on Sunday January 14 at 4:00 P.M. at Michael Chernick's home (75 Cityside Drive at Murray Hill in Montpelier). At 2:30, premeeting skiing will be available from Dave Kissner's and at the same hour, a run was scheduled from Michael's. More updated information will be posted on the CVR web site.

Norm has proposed to amend the CVR Constitution for the purpose of changing the club's business year from the concurrent calendar year to one beginning in April. The intent is to more accurately correspond with our racing activities. Under Norm's plan, future annual meetings, starting in 2002, would be held in March. Officers elected in January 2001, would serve until March 2002. Norm will make this proposal at the Annual Meeting.

As for Leaf Peepers, Harwood Boosters will receive a check in the amount of approximately \$3,300 and the club's final proceeds will total approximately \$1,800. Tim proposed that Curtis' salary for 2001 be raised, with the proviso that he assume greater responsibility for the event. This would include decreasing the number of Leaf Peeper Committee meetings. To accomplish this objective, the club would retain \$1.50 instead of \$2.00 per person. The club's leadership was authorized to negotiate with Curtis upon his return to Vermont in December.

On the electronic front, Donna Smyers reminded everyone that one can join the egroup exclusively for posting purposes. The meeting adjourned at 8:25 P.M.
