<u>Directions to the Martins:</u> Take Exit 6 (S. Barre) off I89. At 2 miles there is a blinking yellow /red traffic light. Turn right on to Miller Rd. Ext. Take immediate left on West Road. Travel south 1.3 miles on West Rd. to the junction with Snow Bridge Road. Turn left (160 degree uphill) on Snow Bridge and travel east for 0.3 miles to Blue Bird Road. Blue Bird is a dead end road. There are three houses on Blue Bird and the Martin house is the house you can not see. Drive to the end of the cul de sac and the driveway. There is room to park about 6 cars in the drive so you may want to consider parking in the turn-a-round and walking to the house.

From Barre drive South on Rt. 14. Turn right just past the former Formula Ford dealership on to Snow Bridge Road. Blue Bird Road is about 2 miles up Snow Bridge and is the only left turn.

CVR OPEN BOARD POSITIONS: We need a new President, Vice President and Treasurer. If interested, please contact Andrea, or attend the annual meeting in March at which time the new positions are nominated and elected. (Details on the March meeting are listed below)

Montpelier Bike Path Work – The city is going to be working on the path for 2-4 months of next summer. The club needs to consider this when planning races and fun runs next summer. Race directors for those races in which the course goes on the bike path, take note to start thinking about alternative courses. Discussed either the National Life Annex or North Branch as alternatives for the fun runs. Decided the National Life Annex would work best. Next steps are for Sandy to contact Tim Shea at National Life and get the necessary permission to use the parking lot. We will stay at the current location until construction begins, at which time we will move the fun runs to the Annex. (assuming we get permission)

Special Request – The GMAA has asked if CVR would be willing to sell them a block of numbers for the Leaf Peepers race next year. This race is part of their race series and they want to be sure their club members can get into the race. Because the race closes at a certain point, buying numbers ahead of time would insure they get into the race. There was a long discussion and the club decided e-mail, phone call and other notification can be given to the GMAA in the same manner as other people and other clubs, to warn them of how full the race is getting, and prior to it closing, a reminder to sign up. This should help them get their runners in the race.

Race Numbers—Andrea has race numbers and safety pins. She will put them in the CVR storage for race directors to use. Remember if your race is part of the ORS series, you should try and use ORS numbers if available. Other races and events can use the numbers that Andrea has.

Race Updates -

It was reported that an estimated 200 people are no shows each year. With that number in mind, maybe we can increase the number of applications accepted by 200 +/-. 
Two Weeks in Georgia

I recently spent a couple of weeks in the sunny south at Macon, Ga. It was nice to escape the Vermont wintry weather for a spell. While there, the weather was near perfect for running, and I was able to find two nearby races.

The Sweetheart Run for Sight in Centerville on Feb. 12th, a half hour south of Macon, featured a 5k and a 12k race. I opted for the longer distance, as I hadn't run anything except 5k races for the longer distance had the sum was heiliant and running conditions. past few months. It was 29 degrees at the 8am start, but the sun was brilliant, and running conditions Were great. The course took us through residential neighborhoods on relatively flat terrain. I parked myself behind two many people at the start, and had to do a lot of fancy footwork to get around many of them (mainly the ipod crowd). The slow start allowed me to do a lot of passing later on, though, and I finished 45th of 138 in a time of 59:14. It was better than I had expected

The following week I signed up for the Al Toll race in Macon on Feb. 19th, put on by the local club, Macon Tracks. Again there was a choice of two distances, a 5k and a Masters 15k. At race time, 9am, the temperature was in the low 50's, so shorts were the uniform of the day. Another glorious, sunny day.
