C.V. Runners Star In Marathon

Ten runners from the Central Vermont Runners Club competed over the weekend at the Foxtrotters Marathon in Foxboro, Mass. The race tast Saturday, Nov. 21, covered 26 miles and 385 yards. It was for the New England Road Runners Championship.

The temperature for the race was in the upper 40's with strong winds, sometimes gusting, that seemed to be in the runners faces most of the way. Even though it rained all day, night and up until about one hour before race time, it didn't seem to dampen the spirits of the approximately 1,200 runners.

The course, besides the wind, seemed like it was always going up a slight incline with little relief. But thanks to the CVR support crews the runners' spirits were kept high. Mark Chaplin was the first CVR across the line and finished a strong 15th overall! Sue Christiansen, competing in her first marathon did an excellent job finishing 18th in her age group.

CVR SUCCESSES AT FOXBORO!

CVR teams proved tough to beat at the 1981 NERRC Marathon Championship race at Foxboro. Mass., on 21 Nov. Paced by hard-running Mark Chaplin (who finished an outstanding 15th overall), Newton Baker and Dick Millar rounded out the CVR Men's Open team which took 2nd place among the 10 teams represented. Only the Middlesex Striders, with a team seere of 298 was able to top CVR's 591.

Meanwhile, CVR's Men's Masters team of Chris Martin, Joe McEntyre and Bob Oatley captured the Masters title unopposed. Considering their performances (led by Martin's 3:01), they would have been tough to beat in any case.

Congratulations to both of our teams and also to our other finishers, Wade Walker, Byron Hill, and first-timers Sue Christiansen and Ray Usle. Ray's account of the experience follows.

FOXBORO MARATHON: A FIRST-TIMER'S VIEW

On November 21, 1981, I completed the Foxtrotter Marathon course at Foxboro, Mass., in the time of 3:44. This was my first marathon and crossing the finish line was no doubt one of the biggest thrills of my life. I have been running semi-seriously for about two years and second last September to attempt a marathon.

Many of the runners complained that the course was always at a slight incline but to me this was the flattest race course I've ever run. Perhaps this is because I've never before run outside of Vermont and do most of my training on hills.

The day was very cold with temperatures in the mid-40's and the wind blowing across the lake was sometimes fierce.

I positioned myself in the back of the pack at the start

and it was a minute and a half later when I crossed the starting line. Facing a distance which I've never run and a wicked case of nerves, I paced myself at eight minute miles for the first twenty miles. felt fine up to that point and thought that it would be easy to finish at that pace, but at 21 miles I ran out of gas. The next four miles were agonizingly slow but the last mile I picked up again Knowing the end was in sight.

A first marathon is truly a learning experience. I feel if I had paced myself faster in the first twenty miles when I felt strong I perhaps would have finished with a better time. I will let you know if this theory works because I am hooked on the thrill of long distance running. I will definitely run another marathon in the year

Bob Murphy opened the meeting with a general discussion of finances, indicating that although we had in excess of \$400.00 in the CVR checking account most of that money is already committed to member T-shirts and newsletter printing and mailing costs. Bob proposed increasing initial membership to \$7.00 and the cost of a T-shirt to \$4.00. The proposal was accepted unanimously by those present. Annual membership dues will remain unchanged.

Discussion followed about additional ways to raise funds. Suggestions included a return to the 25 cent charge for each Tuesday "fun runner"; charging for CVR services in helping to run area races; staging our own race to raise additional funds; rencouraging The Howard Bank to increase its race entry fee as a means of obtaining additional revenue. No vote was taken or resolution made on which alternative to pursue, but all suggestions were favorably received and supported by those present.

Bob Murphy then reported that he had received a mysterious communication from another runner, indicating that the CVR Foxboro Marathon teams may have placed well in the final standings. Bob asked if anyone had information how we placed at Foxboro. No one did, so Joe McEntyre volunteered to check on the matter.

The meeting then turned to selection of officers for 1982. The slate of nominations recommended by Pashal DeBlasio was adopted by unanimous voice vote. Our new officers are: Darrah Ellerson, President; Jeff Shutag, Vice-President; Roger Whitcomb, Treasurer; and yours truly, Secretary.

The annual meeting was preceded by a short three mile fun run by $\frac{\text{SEVEN}}{\Lambda}$ h A hardy (perhaps "foolhardy" is a better term) souls, who trudged through deep snow drifts and braved 40-60 mile an hour wind gusts. Before the meeting we all thoroughly enjoyed a pot luck supper, with mucho food for all.

FRED ROSS SURVIVES "NIFTY FIFTY"

Fred Ross battled a tough, hilly course, blustery cold weather and his own lack of training and conquered the New England Athletics Congress (NEAC) 50 Mile Championship.

Fred discovered only about a month before this race that his fifty miler at Lake Waramaug, Connecticut, in May couldn't be used as a qualifying race for the Western States 100 next June. He quickly began a crash training program as his mileage had been averaging something less than 20 miles per week.

He entered the Essex Junction 50 Miler on Nov 7 but had to drop out after 30 miles with knee problems. His pit crew (yours truly) arrived too late to help him. The weather was wet, snowy and cold and the course hilly.

Two weeks later Fred was on the starting line in Coventry, RI, for his last shot at qualifying for the Western 100 as entries closed Nov 30. This time Fred's pit crew (yours truly again) was there for the entire tough race.

The course consisted of nine laps of 5.37 miles around Flat River Reservoir plus a short leg at the start and finish. Naturally the last 0.835 miles was uphill.

As mentioned above the course was quite hilly. None of the hills were long but there were a lot of them. Fred thought that probably helped him as he got to use all of his leg muscles.

Fred locked quite comfortable for about three laps. He was running for four minutes and walking for one for the first four laps. This changed to $3\frac{1}{2}$ and $1\frac{1}{2}$ for laps five and six and after that he did what he could.

Fred ate some bananas and granola bars (his own) and drank ERG at the two aid stations on the course.

At the end of six laps (33 miles) it looked like it was all over for Fred as he was limping badly and in quite a bit of pain. At this point he took a three minute pit stop and changed shoes. He took some aspirin and went back at it. His pit crew met him at about two mile intervals from there on in and he kept looking better and better.

Just before the last lap the first place woman (47 year old Bev Nolan) caught up with Fred and they ran the last 10K together. This was a big help to both of them considering their fatigue (she had run a 50 the previous weekend) and the fact that it was now dark. They hit the finish line together in 8:52:58 tied for 13th place.

Fred was extremely tired but also extremely jubilant. He had taken the first big step toward his goal of completing the Western 100 in 24 hours. Let's all join in wishing Fred the luck of the draw as entries for the Western 100 are selected by lottery. Fred yows to train if accepted.

From a spectator's viewpoint the race was very long but also very interesting. There were about 30 starters and 15 finishers. The winner was George Gardner who started out at 6:00 per mile and averaged 6:44/mile for the entire fifty. For two or three laps there was quite a contest for first as Ray Nelson of Kingstown, RI was just a short distance back of George and definitely a factor. Unfortunately he became ill and had to withdraw after about 20 miles.

The aid stations were well manned and there was plenty of encouragement for the runners. The race director, Gerry Beagan, who finished fifth, came back out on the course after he finished to check things out and offer encouragement to the runners. Someone mentioned how well he looked and that he seemed to be walking without difficulty. He commented that fifties are a lot easier on the legs than marathons because the pace is so slow.

From my own experience I know that these are easier to recover from than a marathon and I look forward to joining other Central Vermont Runners at Lake Waramaug on May 2, 1982.


