



RACE RESULTS BY COMPUTER

Attention Race Directors: Bob Murphy has recently revised his computer program for race results. If you would like printed results of your race from his program, please make advance arrangements with him (at least two weeks before race date).

Bob needs the following information to "feed" his program. (1) Race entry blanks, with the runner's bib number recorded, (2) finish times, in order, and (3) bib numbers in order of finish.

Output from the program includes (1) complete results, by age/sex group, including finish place (overall and age group), finish time, name, sex, age, hometown, club and pace per mile or km, (2) list of competitors (either alphabetically or by race number) and (3) mailing labels for sending out results to all entrants.

Computer results cannot be made available on race day, but Bob promises to do his best to provide results the next day for duplication and mailing. If interested, please call \$76-4328.

1986 RANKINGS OF VERMONT RUNNERS

Ranking of Vermont resident runners in 1986 has been completed. Although road race performances at all standard certified distances are eligible for ranking, 1986 Rankings of Vermont Runners include performances on the following courses only.

Montpelier 10-Miler, Montpelier 21Jun86
Capital City Stampede 10km, Montpelier 12Jul86
Leafpeepers Half-Marathon, Waterbury 50ct86

(Results of races on other certified courses in 1986 have been requested, but not received.)

Ranking scores awarded for race performances are based on the following table. An individual may receive ranking scores for as many distances as he/she competes in, but will receive only one score (his/her best) at a given distance. Scores are determined by individual race, based on the number of finishers in the group in question. Although Vermont residents and non-residents are considered for the purpose of ranking score awarded in a given event, only Vermont residents are eligible for comparative ranking.


